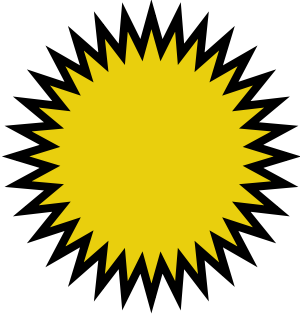

Each summer, Tri-Development Center and the Aiken County Board of Disabilities help to fund and coordinate a variety of recreational opportunities to children and youth with disabilities in Aiken County. Examples of activities include mainstreaming children in private pre-schools and day care centers. This year, funding has also been used to assist children and adults with disabilities not on Medicaid Waivers in attending summer day and overnight camps, swimming lessons, and karate, drawing, pottery and dance classes, as well as lots of other venues with their peers without disabilities.

To receive the benefits of Tri-Development Center's Summer Services, interested individuals need to contact their Service Coordinators or Early Interventionists at whatever agency is their service coordination/early intervention provider. Let them know you would like to be referred for Summer Services which is one of the few available services for which waiting lists do not apply. Available funds are allocated on a first come, first serve basis. This funding is not available for individuals served through one of the Medicaid Waivers; however, if you are on a Medicaid Waiver, and are interested in what activities in the area you might find enjoyable, feel free to call Tawanda at the number listed below.
