Laurens Street ICF/ID: Tri-Development Center operates four Intermediate Care Facilities for People with Intellectual Disabilities (ICFs/ID). All four of these homes are within the city limits of Aiken, SC. The home pictured on the left is the Laurens Street ICF/ID located at 728 Laurens Street. Eight men live in this eight bedroom home and enjoy a variety of activities.

Linden Street ICF/ID: Pictured on the right is 136 Linden Street which is the home of eight wonderful ladies. Each of these ladies needs a great deal of support, but none of them lacks the ability to make anyone smile. Individual habilitation plans are developed for all who live in our ICFs/ID and include objectives to be implemented to increase individuals' independence in a variety of areas.



Dupont II ICF/ID: The eight ladies who live at Dupont II, located at 129 Dupont Drive, have a great time dressing up for special occasions. Dedicated staff members including nursing staff are present to provide them with whatever assistance is needed. Like their friends who live in the other ICFs/ID, they participate in activities at the day program on Vacluse Road. This home has four semi-private bedrooms.

Dupont I ICF/ID: The eight men who live at 127 Dupont Drive all have very distinctive personalities. Staff members frequently comment that working with them is a very rewarding experience. Not so very many years ago, our community like other communities around the nation had no support systems in place to meet the needs of these individuals, and large institutions were the only options available to them.
